Kindergarten – Grade 3

- ▶ Complete change of school uniform look-alike clothes for emergencies (label each item with child's name)
- ▶ Reusable Water Bottle (spill proof)
- ▶ Regular-size Backpack (NO wheels, NO characters)
- ▶ Individual Headphones – no earbuds – no USB connection (for educational platforms) Students NOT to share.
- ▶ 1 Non-perishable lunch for emergencies (3-4 items in ziplock)
- ▶ 2 containers Disinfectant Wipes
- ▶ 1 box 100 count plastic Spoons
- ▶ 1 box 100 count plastic Forks
- ▶ 1 Pack of Paper Plates 100 count (not heavy duty, not Styrofoam)
- ▶ 1 large box Tissues

Grades 4-5

- ▶ Reusable pull-top Sports Water Bottle
- ▶ Backpack (NO wheels, NO characters)
- ▶ Individual Headphones – not earbuds – with microphone (for educational platforms) Students NOT to share.
- ▶ 1 (80 count +) container Disinfectant wipes
- ▶ Girls: 1 box 100 count plastic Forks
1 (100 count) Lightweight Paper plates – no Styrofoam
1 large box gallon size Ziplock bags
- ▶ Boys: 1 box 100 plastic Spoons
1 large box tissues
1 large box sandwich size Ziplock bags

Grades 6-8

Homeroom:

- ▶ Bible (bring the one you have)
 - ▶ 1 package of loose leaf 3 hole punched lined notebook paper
 - ▶ 1½ inch 3-ring binder with 5 dividers
 - ▶ Pens
 - ▶ #2 pencils
 - ▶ pencil pouch
 - ▶ Metric ruler (metal or hard plastic)
 - ▶ 1 large container Disinfectant wipes
 - ▶ 2 large box Kleenex

Homeroom:

 - ▶ 1 package of lightweight paper plates (no Styrofoam)

- ▶ Bible (Any version you find easiest to read and understand)
- ▶ Black pens/Red Pens
- ▶ #2 pencils or mechanical pencils
- ▶ Highlighters

Grades K-5

- ▶ White or light-colored rubber-soled athletic shoes
- ▶ White, navy, or black solid-colored socks (no dress socks)
- ▶ Water Bottle

Grades 6-10

- ▶ P.E. Shorts modest fit (Purchase WMA Dennis Uniform)
- ▶ Yellow P.E. Shirt (Purchase WMA Dennis Uniform)
- ▶ Blue P.E. Shirt (Purchase WMA Dennis Uniform)
- ▶ Knee high sports socks (**solid WHITE** – no stripes, no dress socks)
- ▶ Ankle high-top **White or Light-colored Rubber-soled** athletic shoes (no converse or vans type skate shoes; no platform shoes (shoe must cover & support ankle bone)
- ▶ Shin guards (found in sporting goods area of Walmart)
- ▶ Knee support and Ankle support - pull on wraps (no Velcro) (found in pharmacy area of Walmart)
- ▶ Reusable Water Bottle
- ▶ Mouth guard (case strongly suggested, found in sporting goods area of Walmart)
- ▶ P.E. bag (can be drawstring type or duffel bag style)

- ▶ Girls: Navy blue skorts*
WMA logo white rounded-collar Peter Pan shirt*
Black Dress shoes with white socks
- ▶ Boys: Navy blue pants *
WMA logo white long sleeve oxford button-down collar shirt*
Clip-on Harris plaid tie*
Black Dress shoes with dark socks

Steel Band – (Grade 5-7 Elective)

- ▶ Solid color polo shirt (**NOT** black)
- ▶ Black tuxedo pants

Concert/Intermediate Band - Grades 6-12

- ▶ Ladies wear knee length skirts

Informal Attire:

- ▶ Black "T" shirt**
- ▶ Hawaiian/Calypso shirt**
- ▶ Black tuxedo pants**
