Attendance and GPA is Vital

Attendance and a high GPA (grade point average) is critical in the learning and development of each child. Is your child prepared for their college? While going through the quarter reports, high school student grades and attendance are not where they should be if students expect to pursue college or university. GPA and attendance matters!

Unexcused Tardies and Attendance

To provide your child an outstanding education, your child must maintain on-time attendance and attend school regularly. Students receiving state scholarships must have 90% class attendance to maintain receiving funding. Parents - please talk to your child about the importance of being accountable and striving for a good GPA with consistent attendance to support the academic success for progress in their future.

A new quarter has started. Let's turn over a new leaf – get to school on time and attend your classes! Student that acquires five (5) unexcused absences or ten (10) unexcused tardies will be required to pay a \$50 fee prior to child's reentry to class.

Items Left on Campus

Every day after school there are lunch boxes, backpacks, textbooks, calculators, binders, uniforms (jackets, PE clothes, etc.) water bottles. and other miscellaneous items left lying around campus. PLEASE take these items home. Unclaimed items that are not labeled with student names will be sent to Community Services at the end of each week to avoid the growing pile and for critter control.
