Tuition Fee: Fees will be divided over a 10-month period from August through May, meaning, 10% of Annual Tuition is due by August 4, 2024. Beginning in September and for each following month of the school year, the next 10% is due by the monthly due date.

Application Fee (One Time): \$27.00 per student. This is non-refundable and due with each application.

Registration Fee (Annual): New student \$150/student or \$300/family. Returning student discount \$100/student or \$200/family if registered on or before March 1, 2025. After March 1 the fee will be \$150/student or \$300/family. This is non-refundable and due at time of registration.

Grants/Scholarships: Scholarships are available from local Seventh-Day Adventist churches, Walker Memorial Academy, Step Up for Students including , Family Empowerment Scholarships for unique abilities, and AAA Scholarship Foundation. For students with any scholarships, please email the award ID# to diana.rodriquez@wmaeagles.org Families should also check with their church pastor or church treasurer to see if their home church offers scholarships.

Advance Payment Tuition Discount: A 2% discount is offered when a semester is paid in advance. When a year is paid in advance a 3% discount is offered.

Walker Memorial Academy Late Payment Fee: A \$25 fee will be applied each month to accounts which are over 30 days late. Separate late payment fees may be applied to third party billing. Additionally, if any amount of a school bill is ninety (90) days past due, as of December 31 of that school year, including any scholarship payments not approved and older than 15 days, that amount can be reported on an IRS form 1099 from Walker Memorial Academy in the responsible party's name for income tax reporting and income tax purposes.

Unpaid Tuition/Unpaid Balances: Tuition is considered late if you miss your scheduled payment. If the account becomes delinquent, report cards will be held, and the child may be withheld from class until arrangements are made. Parents whose tuition accounts are delinquent will not be able to re-enroll their children without satisfying their previous debts.

Payment Methods: Payments to Walker Memorial Academy can be made using cash, checks, debit and credit cards. Recurring payment can also be set up through your personal bank.
