

Walker Memorial Academy Homeschool & Part-Time Enrollment Program

Walker Memorial Academy (WMA) welcomes homeschool and part-time students who desire to participate in the academic excellence and Christ-centered environment that define our school community. Our program is designed to provide meaningful educational opportunities while maintaining consistency, accountability, and compliance with Florida education requirements.

Academic Participation

Homeschool and part-time students may enroll in approved WMA classes and attend in person during their scheduled class times. Students are expected to meet the same academic, attendance, conduct, and dress code standards required of full-time WMA students. Records, transcripts, and any learning support needs are reviewed through the standard admissions process

Dual Enrollment Opportunities

Home education students may pursue dual enrollment directly through participating colleges. WMA-sponsored dual enrollment is available primarily for full-time students and, in certain cases, for part-time students who meet established academic and enrollment requirements.

Technology Access

Part-time students may utilize either a WMA-issued device, subject to applicable technology fees, or a personal device connected through the school's filtered network. All users must comply with WMA's technology and acceptable use policies.

Field Trips and Signature Experiences

Part-time students may be eligible for selected field trips and signature experiences. Priority is given to full-time WMA students. Participation opportunities for part-time students are based on enrollment history, available space, and applicable trip costs.

Scholarships and Financial Requirements

Families using Florida scholarship programs, including Step Up for Students' Personalized Education Program (PEP), must maintain all scholarship requirements, including learning plans, annual testing, and approved payment procedures through the scholarship funding organization.

Volunteer and Chaperone Requirements

To ensure student safety, all parents or guardians serving as volunteers, field trip chaperones, or in roles involving student supervision must complete the required Level 2 background screening and volunteer training.

Extracurricular Participation

WMA athletics and extracurricular programs are designed primarily for fully enrolled WMA students. Participation opportunities for homeschool and part-time students are subject to school eligibility policies and available programming.

Policies are reviewed regularly and may be adjusted to ensure compliance, sustainability, and the safety of all students and staff.
